- Raise as much money as you can

- Wear comfortable clothes
- Wear comfortable footwear : trainers with good socks
- Bring with you in your small back pack :
 - A waterproof coat – if it's going to rain
 - At least 1 litre of a drink - water is best
 - Your lunch and any snacks you will need for the walk
(slow release carbohydrates are best – beware of sugary drinks/sweets)
 - Any medication you need – your inhaler
- Walk don't run ... it's a long way
- Bring a few plasters just in case you get blisters
- Please bring your mobile phone (to be used in an emergency only)
- Texting and walking don't really mix – so be careful
- IPods and MP3 players may distract : you should leave them at home
- For safety, walk in groups of 3 to 5, but be careful not to block the footpath
- Be considerate to other walkers and path users: keep to the LEFT if possible
- Please put all sweet wrappers and other rubbish in bins or take it home
- If there is an emergency, talk to a member of staff on the towpath
- Once you are back at school, register so we know you have completed the walk
- Cheer on and congratulate all those who finish !

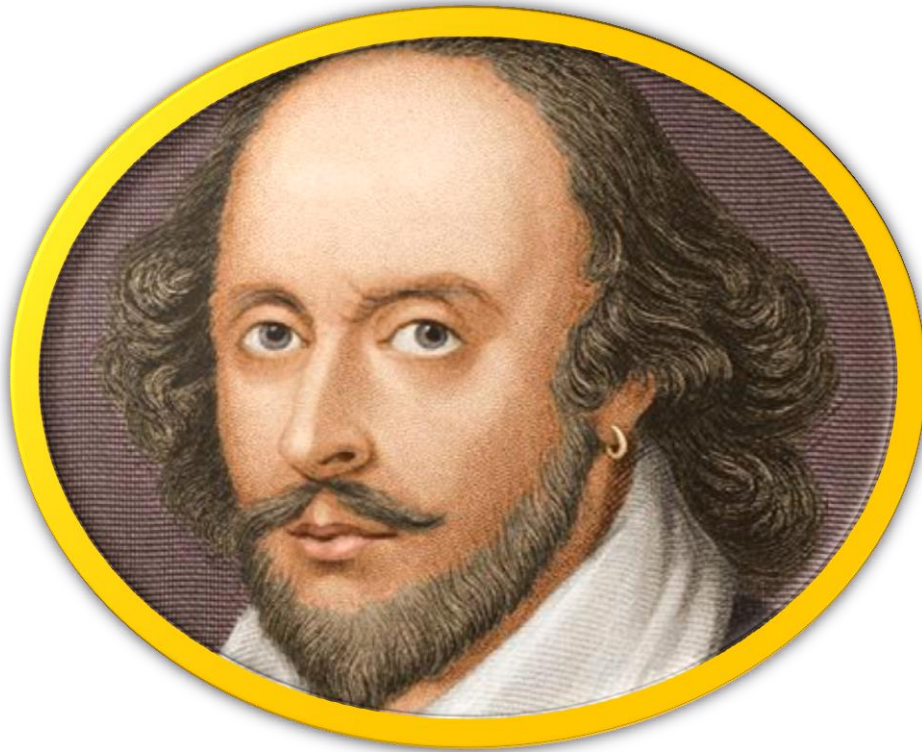
