Julian House operates more than 20 different projects, accommodation sites and social enterprises, mainly in Bath, but also in Bristol, South Gloucestershire, Somerset, Wiltshire & Devon. In total the charity manages 132 bed spaces, for clients with a wide spectrum of needs. The **emergency hostel** (30 beds) in Bath is open 7 days a week, 24hrs a day and provides primary health care, mental health and resettlement support. There is also an **assertive outreach service** - providing a real opportunity for people wanting to move away from rough sleeping. Building trusting relationships with clients is central to our successful resettlement work.



Various **supported housing projects** provide move-on accommodation and targeted support for those suffering domestic violence, addiction recovery, individuals with learning difficulties, men and women with a history of offending, as well as older clients.

Unemployment is a significant feature for people with experiences of addiction, homelessness and/or a history of offending. There is clear evidence that employment can be the major contributing factor in helping individuals to transform their lives for the better. However, achieving this goal can present real challenges.

Against this backdrop Julian House launched its first **social enterprise** in 2010, Bath Bike Workshop - offering practical work experience and training. Since then other workshops have opened in Bristol, Trowbridge and Exeter.
