Once all the content has been covered all lessons will be focused on exam techniques covering all 4 skill areas. We will also do practise papers. You will focus on IRP and speaking card skills with Cristina and Mr Hall. Mr Hall will also focus on book and film skills. Mrs Hall will concentrate on topics, exam skills and grammar revision.

By the end of the Easter holidays you will need to have revised your AS themes at A2 Level but also the A2 themes. Kerboodle is an excellent resource. Topic-specific vocabulary needs to be recalled easily. Your grammar should be at the required standard for A2 i.e. accurate conjugation of verbs in different tenses, word order, cases and adjective endings. You should aim to re-watch the film and to read the book and study guides again. Use the resources you are given to help you plan potential answers. Lists of speaking questions should be used as a guide of what to expect in the speaking exam. The IRP presentation and discussion material should be perfected.

Once study leave begins should anyone wish to come in and study with some support, Mr and Mrs Hall will be available during the slots when your lessons would have taken place.

We will also be available at other times up until the exams - just email us to arrange a time or simply pop into the office.
