



## **Sixth Form Tuition Fund Statement**

### **What is the fund?**

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is of one-off funding for the 2020 to 2021 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19). The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. All supported students must be on a 16 to 19 study programme and providers should prioritise support for students who have not achieved a grade 4 in English and/or maths.

### **Funding allocation to Beechen Cliff**

Beechen Cliff has been awarded £2640.

### **How the funding has been used at Beechen Cliff**

The Sixth Form offers additional support and tuition for students who continue to study maths or English at Post 16 and who have not yet achieved a Grade 4. The additional funding is used to provide lessons for students retaking GCSE English or Maths, with four hours a fortnight timetabled for each retake subject throughout the Autumn term until the November examinations and continued timetabled lessons for the remainder of the academic year for those students who will be taking summer resit exams.

All tuition is provided by specialist teachers in small classes.
