Cognitive Ability Assessments (CATs) and New Group Reading Tests (NGRT)

Pupils are invited to participate in a morning or afternoon testing session. Please note that no preparation is required for these tests. Tests are taken on computers and all instructions are read aloud in addition to being written on the screen. As such, pupils who may have accessed a reader in their SATs will not require this for these tests. These are timed tests and as such extra time is not given. Pastoral System

From September we are making some changes to our pastoral care system.

We will be moving from a structure solely based around the House System to one where we have both a year-based pastoral system and a cross-year House system running concurrently.

We will have five Heads of Year who will be responsible for the pastoral care, wellbeing, safety and behaviour of pupils in their year group. The Head of Year 7 will be Ms Milland, who is in charge of Year 7 transition and is also visiting pupils in their primary schools as part of the transition process.

In addition, we will retain four Houses (Byron, Kipling, Milton and Shakespeare) with Heads of House who are responsible for their House community and personal development opportunities for pupils. This will include inter-house competitions, House councils, community projects and charity fundraising. Where pupils have older siblings at Beechen Cliff, we will endeavour to place them in the same House as them.

Further details, including House allocations, will be provided at the New Parents Evening on 26th June.
