The Aim of the Options Process

- To enable all pupils to study at broad and ambitious curriculum at KS4
- To provide a curriculum which meets pupils' needs and interests
- To ensure each pupil's curriculum effectively prepares them for the next stage in their education.



The Core Curriculum

Everybody studies:

- English Language GCSE
- English Literature GCSE
- Combined Science (2 GCSEs) or Separate Sciences (3 GCSEs)
- Maths GCSE
- PE and Games
- Tutorial and PSHE Programme



Option Choices

In addition pupils choose four other subjects to study in Year 10 and 11



Curriculum Pathways

To help pupils make choices that best suit them, we have two "pathways" which they can follow.

A third option is to attend a different school - which a very small minority of pupils choose to do each year.



Standard Options Pathway

For most pupils the following choices are available:

- Choose either History or Geography
- Choose a Modern Foreign Language (French, German, Spanish or Italian)
- Choose two other subjects (a second humanities subject and/or language may be chosen)



Bespoke Options

For pupils who would benefit from a slightly less constrained range of options, any four subjects can be chosen, but no requirement to study a Language.

This could also include additional Literacy and Numeracy.







Frequently Asked Questions



When will the choices be confirmed?

- Confirmation of allocation will be given in June
- Majority of students study their first choice subjects
- Where it is not possible to allocate all of a pupils' choices, we will take into account order of preference and allocate reserve choices if necessary.
- If combination of first choice subjects does not fit or a group is unviable due to lack of interest – a discussion with pupils will take place



Are pupils on different pathways taught in different groups?

No – all pupils are taught together



My son really wants to study a subject but only if he is taught by Mr/Ms X

This can't be guaranteed. It is better to make choices based on the subject rather than the teacher



Does any subject require equipment or a cost?

- For Photography GCSE a digital SLR camera is needed
- For Hospitality & Catering ingredients will need to be supplied by the pupil
- For Design & Technology some resources may need to be provided for the final project

Pupil Premium support available



Do I need to be good at a subject to take it for GCSE?

It is sensible to take subjects that you do well in but enjoyment of the subject is also important.

To ensure pupils have made appropriate decisions the choices will be shared with Heads of Subject and if there are concerns you will be contacted.



Options that can't go together

Music GCSE and Music Technology L2

We also recommend that pupils don't do the following:

- Computer Science GCSE and Interactive Media L1/2
- Art GCSE and Photography GCSE.



Can a pupil change their mind on a subject later in the year?

Yes – but not all options will be available – some groups may be full or the combination of subjects may not work.

No changes after October.



What is the total number of GCSEs available?

Normally 9 – but up to 11 if Separate Sciences and/or an additional GCSE is taken



What about additional GCSEs?

Native Language GCSEs:

Recommended: Contact the Examinations Officer

Enrichment Options e.g. Further Maths GCSE

Top set Maths – contact Ms Hedger

Other possible qualifications

GCSE Statistics may be available for some students

We are also investigating a vocational sport qualification.



Will pupils be set in Year 10/11?

Setting occurs in Maths and Science in Year 10/11 and to some extent in English.

All option subjects are taught in mixed ability groupings.



Can my son choose whether to study Separate Sciences or Combined Science for GCSE?

As part of the options process you can indicate a preference. However, the final decision will be at the discretion of the Science Faculty.
