Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach some of the New Year 7 transition events, please see below for more information about how we support pupils with Special Educational Needs.

We recognise that the transition from primary school to secondary school can be a daunting prospect, particularly for any pupil with additional learning needs. To support pupils in this process we offer a number of additional visit days which all pupils with additional learning needs are invited to.

During these sessions pupils undertake a range of tasks which include tours of the school with older pupils, getting to know you games and activities with peers, and question and answer sessions to learn more about how the school works on a day-to-day basis.
