

GCSE Exam Success

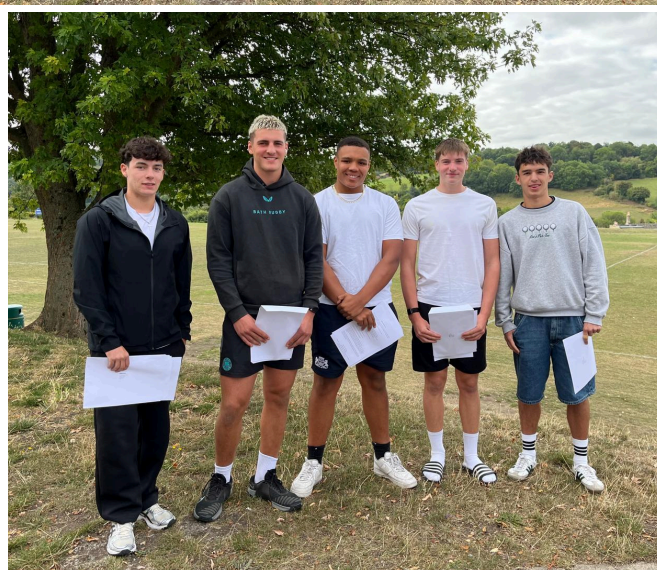
Beechen Cliff students have celebrated another fantastic set of GCSE results this summer.

At GCSE 82% of grades achieved were grades 9-4 and 35% were grades 9-7, well above the national average for England this year.

80% of pupils achieved a grade 4 or above in both English and Maths (65% achieved a grade 5 or above) and 48% of pupils achieved the EBacc, giving them a strong basis for the next stage of their education.

They are now moving on to Sixth Form, College, Apprenticeships and, in a couple of cases, professional sports contracts and we wish them all the very best with their next steps.

Head of Year 11, Pat MacDonald, said "it has been a pleasure to see the boys grow over the last couple of years and their hard work has paid off with some fantastic grades and many great memories of their time at Beechen Cliff. Many congratulations to them!"
