Our Curriculum:

The Beechen Cliff curriculum is designed to provide students with the necessary **knowledge, skills** and **qualifications** to enable them to thrive in their next steps in education or work.

It is designed to be **broad** and **ambitious**. It is designed to meet their needs and interests whilst promoting **British Values** and covering students' **spiritual, moral, social** and **cultural** development.



The Core Curriculum

Everybody studies:

- Maths GCSE
- English Language GCSE
- English Literature GCSE
- Combined Science (2 GCSEs) or Separate Sciences (3 GCSEs)
- PE and Games - Not qualifications
- Tutorial and PSHE Programme

In addition students choose four other subjects to study in Year 10 and 11



Curriculum Pathways



To help students make choices that best suit them, we have two “pathways” which they can follow. A third option is to attend a different school - which a very small minority of students choose.



Standard Options Pathway

For most students the following choices are available:

- Choose either History or Geography
- Choose a Modern Foreign Language (French, German or Spanish)
- Choose two other subjects (a second humanities subject and/or language may be chosen)

Drama GCSE

Bespoke Options Pathway



Advice for making decisions

- Think for yourself and do your research – don't do what your friends are doing
- Focus on the subject rather than personalities
- Think long term – find out what you need to achieve your goals beyond Beechen Cliff: 6th Form, College, University, work etc.
- Ask questions about the subjects
- Pick reserve subjects that you actually want to do
- Discuss your option choices with teachers and parents – listen to their advice

When will the choices be confirmed?

- Confirmation of allocation will be given in June
- Every effort is made to allocate student's first preferences. However, this is not always possible and therefore we will take into account order of preference and allocate reserve choices if necessary. Further detail is available in the Options Booklet.
- Preference order (including reserve choices) is therefore important.

Are students on different pathways taught in different groups?

No – all students are taught together



**My son really wants to study a
subject but only if he is taught
by Mr/Ms X?**

This can't be guaranteed. It is better to make choices based on the subject rather than the teacher



Does any subject require equipment or a cost?

- For Photography GCSE a digital SLR camera is needed
- For Hospitality & Catering ingredients will need to be supplied by the student
- For Design & Technology some resources may need to be provided for the final project

Pupil Premium support available



Do I need to be good at a subject to take it for GCSE?

It is sensible to take subjects that you do well in but enjoyment of the subject is also important.

To ensure students have made appropriate decisions the choices will be shared with Heads of Subject and if there are concerns you will be contacted.



Options that can't go together

- Music GCSE **and** Music Technology L2
- We also recommend that students don't study both Art GCSE **and** Photography GCSE.



Can a student change their mind on a subject later in the year?

Yes, but not all options will be available

Some groups may be full or the combination of subjects may not work.

No changes after October.



What is the total number of GCSEs available?

Normally 9 – but up to 11 if Separate Sciences and/or an additional GCSE is taken



What about additional GCSEs?

Native Language GCSEs:

Recommended: Contact the Examinations Officer

Enrichment Options e.g. Further Maths GCSE

Top set Maths – contact Mr Burnby

Other possible qualifications

GCSE Statistics may be available for some students



Will students be set in Year 10/11?

Setting occurs in Maths and Science in Year 10/11 and to some extent in English.

All option subjects are taught in mixed ability groups.



Can my son choose whether to study Separate Sciences or Combined Science for GCSE?

As part of the options process you can indicate a preference. However, the final decision will be at the discretion of the Science Faculty.
