Welcome to THE week

Activities Week at Beechen Cliff is a vital aspect of the school year that gives the boys and staff the opportunity to experience a range of activities in a variety of settings undertaking an array of challenges and stepping outside their comfort zone. Please be aware that it is not first come first served but all selection should be complete by **17:00 on Monday 30th March** to allow the allocation process to commence.

- Coordination and allocation will take place the following week and we will endeavour to honour as many first choice activities as possible and ensure a fair and equitable distribution where possible.

- All payments must be concluded **by Friday 29th May**.
