Respect - Showing an understanding of the feelings, wishes and rights of others through words and actions and by valuing equality and diversity within the community.

This document sets out the minimum expectations of students, parents and the school. **By enrolling into the Sixth Form, you are agreeing to the following:**

1) As a Beechen Cliff student I agree to:

- attend school regularly, maintaining at least 95% attendance (including tutor sessions, PSHE and independent study)
- be punctual at all times
- work hard and meet all teaching requirements
- complete homework and independent study tasks on time
- adhere to the Sixth Form dress code at all times
- regularly check school emails for communications from staff
- treat all members of the school community with understanding and respect
- communicate with teachers to collect work if unwell before the next lesson
- ensure my mobile phone is only used in the Sixth Form centre and study spaces
- be polite and show respect for the school environment and property
- adhere to the school rules and behave in a responsible way, both in school and when travelling to and from school
- not use any tobacco, alcohol, vapes, snus, illegal drugs on the school site or immediate vicinity
- embrace the school's Core Values and act as a role model to younger pupils

2) As Parent/Carer I agree to:

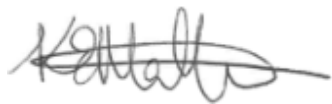
- promote excellent attendance (minimum 95%) and punctuality, and inform the school on the each day of any absence before 9.00am
- avoid family holidays during school term time
- attend Parents' Evenings, school functions (where relevant), and any meetings as requested
- support the school Behaviour Policy, including sanctions
- pay for the repair of any damage to school property if caused by my child
- ensure my child is fully equipped and suitably dressed for school
- be aware of the social responsibilities with regard to using the internet and social media

- check communication from the school via Arbor Parent App and/or email

3) Beechen Cliff School will:

- endeavour to ensure that students are safe and happy whilst at school
- maintain contact with parent/carers on matters of conduct and welfare
- provide regular lessons and academic support for students
- set, mark and monitor homework and assessments
- support students in upholding the standards expected of Sixth Form students
- arrange Parents' Evenings during which progress will be discussed
- keep parents/carers informed about school activities through weekly Sixth Form Bulletin, email notifications on Arbor, and via the school website
- provide opportunities for students to grow and thrive beyond the academic curriculum
- invite parents to face to face meetings if an issue is considered serious

We agree that if the student fails to adhere to these agreed conditions (other than for previously agreed extenuating circumstances), then this will be escalated through our Student Monitoring System procedures (as outlined in the Code of Conduct), with a possible eventual outcome being the withdrawal of the student's place to study.
