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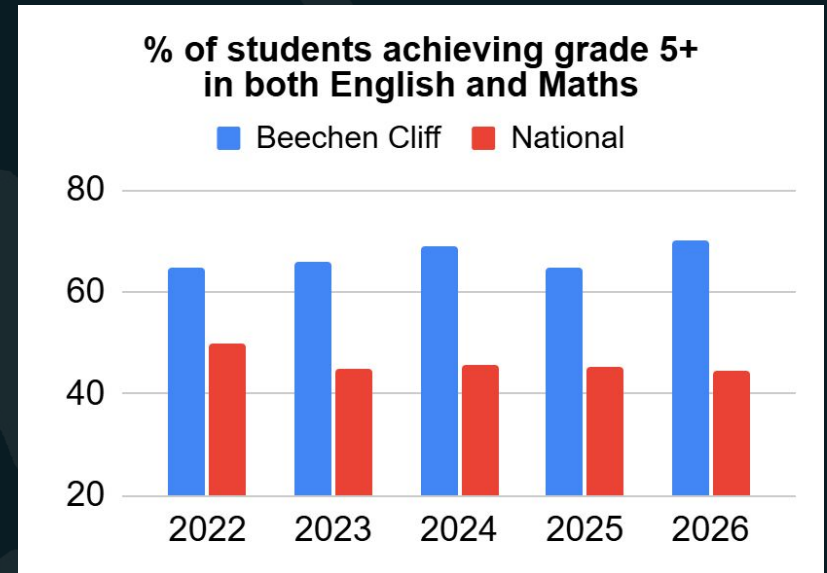
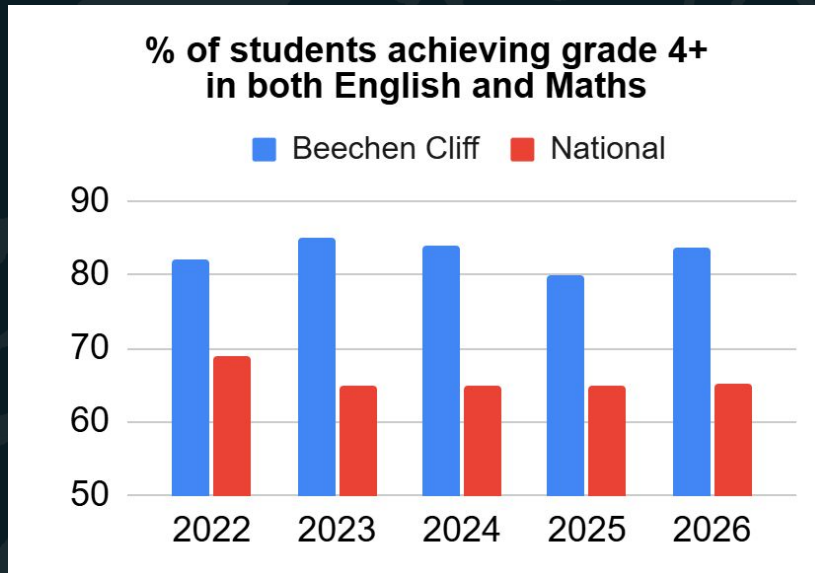
Beechen Cliff

- High achieving, with exceptional attainment and progress for boys

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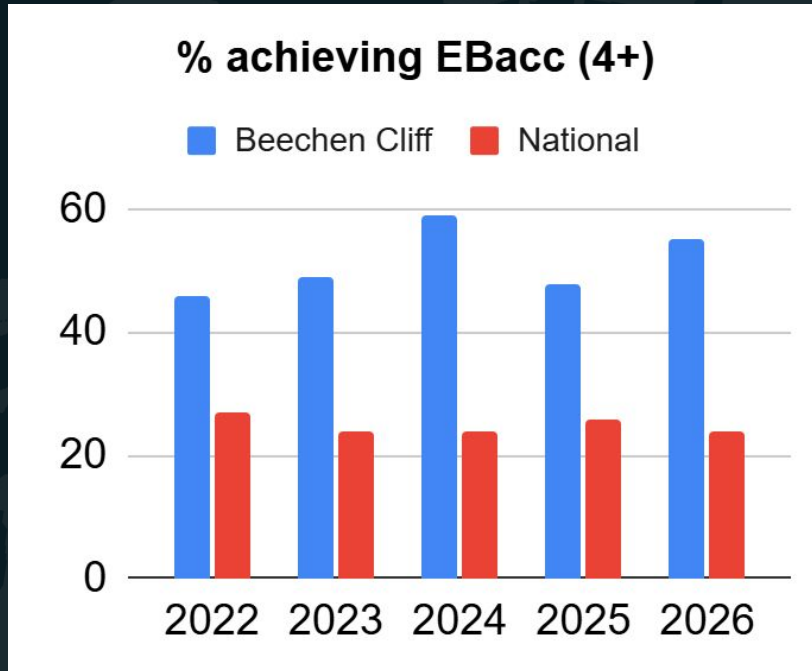
Attainment & Progress
